# DPAC SAFETY POLICIES

## WHAT DPAC IS DOING TO KEEP YOU SAFE:

All dancers entering the facility must complete and return the liability waiver via DocuSign. DPAC Admin is monitoring liability waiver submissions and teachers will not permit dancers into the facility unless it is completed.

In order to keep DPAC a healthy environment, we have professional cleaning and sanitizing services 5 days/week. Additionally, Front Desk staff sanitizes common areas and commonly touched surfaces Monday-Friday. Every studio has its own cleaning supplies that instructors utilize to sanitize studios after every private lesson.

Strictly enforced arrival and departure protocol for all dancers allows staff to sanitize private lesson rooms and safely escort dancers in the studio.

All DPAC faculty must be symptom-free. Faculty will be mandated to provide proof of a self-temperature check and completion of the [standardized employee screening questionnaire](#) prior to entering the facility.

We also have procedures in place to screen dancers for symptoms prior to their private lesson, if necessary.

To further enforce the required 6ft social distancing, we will have decals placed on studio room floors, indicating safe distances for dancers and instructors.

While we are prioritizing safety, we want our dancers to HAVE FUN! Our instructors are so excited to see dancers face to face and regain as much normalcy as possible, as safely as possible.

## HOW YOU CAN HELP US KEEP YOU SAFE:

Please sign the liability waiver via DocuSign before your private lesson. This is **required for entry**. Check your email for the liability waiver DocuSign.

Upon arrival, please **wait in your car outside**. Instructors will pick your dancer up in the parking lot and escort them to their private lesson. **NO PARENTS, SIBLINGS, OR VISITORS ALLOWED IN STUDIO AT ANY TIME.**

Masks are required in all common areas. Masks may be removed in the private lesson studio room with instructor and dancer/parent approval. Continue to maintain 6ft social distance when in the studio.

All dancers and instructors are required to wash their hands prior to entering their private lesson. Instructors will ask students to wash their hands before entering if they have not done so.

Dancers are required to bring a personal yoga mat for floor warm-ups and stretching. Please leave street shoes outside the private lesson studio room, as they are not permitted within the studio room. Dancers must wear dance shoes or socks once in the studio room- **NO BARE FEET.**

After the private lesson, instructors will escort your dancer back to the parking lot. **Dancers must be picked up promptly.**

These changes may seem **very new** to your dancers. Please inform them of these changes and explain that this will keep them and their instructors safe and healthy.

# DPAC SAFETY POLICIES

## ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, please wait in the parking lot. Instructors will meet you at your car and escort your dancer to the private lesson. Leave non-essentials such as dance bags or extra dance shoes in the car. NO PARENTS, SIBLINGS, OR VISITORS ALLOWED IN STUDIO AT ANY TIME.

## WEAR A MASK

All dancers are required to wear a mask in common areas, including the lobby, hallways, and upstairs cubby areas. With instructor and parent/dancer approval, masks may be removed once in the private lesson studio.

## WASH YOUR HANDS

All dancers are required to wash their hands with soap and warm water for 20 seconds prior to their private lesson. Restrooms are located upstairs and downstairs. Hand sanitizer stations are available throughout the studio.

## BEFORE ENTERING THE DANCE ROOM

Instructors will confirm that dancers have washed their hands. Leave street shoes outside of the dance room. Personal yoga mats, water bottles, and dance shoes are the only permitted items inside the dance room.

## MAINTAIN 6FT SOCIAL DISTANCE

While in common areas and in private lessons, please maintain at least 6ft social distance. We would love to give you high fives and hugs, but please no touching of any kind.

## DEPARTURE

Dancers must be picked up **promptly**. Please arrive 5 minutes before the end of your dancer's private lesson and wait in the parking lot. After the private lesson, instructors will escort your dancer back to your car.
